

# What to Pack

## 2026 High School Summer Program

We have tried to include all the big items you may need while staying on campus! But don't forget to think about what makes you most comfortable and what you need for travel, study, and fun.

Summer at Landmark can be quite warm, but mornings, evenings, and air-conditioned settings often call for layered clothing. Clothing should allow for safe movement, support active learning and participation, and ensure comfort throughout the day, while accounting for changing Vermont weather.

**Important Reminders** - Label belongings when possible, bring only what you can carry/manage independently, and avoid bringing valuables or anything irreplaceable.

### Room Items Provided

- Bed (twin XL size)
- Desk & desk chair
- Closet
- Bureau drawers (4 – under the bed)
- Overhead light
- Wireless internet service

### Items to Bring

#### Room & Sleeping

- Sheets (twin XL)
- Pillow & blanket/comforter
- Alarm clock
- Wastebasket
- Window or desk fan (recommended)
- Surge-protected power strip

#### Shower & Hygiene

- Shower caddy or bag
- 2-3 bath towels & washcloths
- Shampoo & conditioner
- Bodywash or soap
- Shower shoes/flip-flops (required)
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
- Deodorant
- Hairbrush/comb
- Razor & shaving cream
- Menstrual/Period products

#### Clothing

- T-shirts or casual tops (7–8)
- Shorts, jeans, or casual pants (4–5)
- Sweatshirt or hoodie (1–2)
- Light jacket or rain layer (1)
- Comfortable shoes/sneakers/flip-flops (2–3 pairs)

- Underwear (7–10 pairs)
- Socks (7–10 pairs)
- Pajamas or sleepwear (2–3 sets)
- Athletic wear; swimsuit
- Hat and/or sunglasses
- **Laundry bag, detergent, dryer sheets, and quarters (laundry is expected at least weekly)**

### Electronics & Practical Items

- Laptop or tablet (device settings should allow for administrative privileges)
- Phone and charger
- Headphones or earbuds
- Power strip or extension cord

### Daily Living & Organization

- Backpack or day bag
- Reusable water bottle
- Sunscreen and bug spray
- Hand sanitizer and tissues
- Small flashlight
- Books or reading material
- Cards or small games
- Small refrigerators and microwaves are allowed and can also be rented from the College Bookstore (802-387-6862).

### Things you may NOT have on campus:

- No open flames, heating coils, matches, candles, incense, toaster ovens, space heaters, or grills.
- No alcohol, alcohol containers, illicit or non-prescribed drugs, or drug paraphernalia.
- No explosives, firearms, knives, firecrackers, or other weapons.
- No decorations that hang from the ceiling.
- No tobacco products, vapes, or vape cartridges.
- No pets.
